MINSTRELS From July 25 to 27

teachers: Jean-Pierre Canihac & Daniel Lassalle

Initially, the instruments that can participate are cornettos, sackbuts, dulcians, serpents and shawms, although other instruments can be added.

It is essential to play with historical instruments.

The teacher could make an active students selection from the received applications.

Is required a minimum of 6 students to carry out this section.

CONTINUO WORKSHOP From July 27 to 29

teacher: Aníbal Soriano

Only plucked string players can participate.

It is essential to play with an historical instrument: tiorba, baroque guitar, lute or archilute.

The work with the teacher will take place on the 27th outside the Baroque orchestra and on days 28 to 30 within the rehearsals of the orchestra.

FLUTES CONSORT From July 27 to 29

teacher: David Antich

Recorders and flutes can participate. All of them must be historic ones (renaissance and baroque consort flutes consort).

Each student must provide his own instrument. Furthermore, the teacher will lend his own consort in order to be played during the Course.

Renaissance flutes should be with a pitch A= 440 Hz and the baroque ones A=440/415 Hz.

Teacher could make a students selection in case of applications excess. In that case there will have priority for students from 5th and 6th intermediate degree to the advanced level.

Is required a minimum of 6 students to carry out this section.

HARPSICHORD From July 27 to 29

teacher: Ignasi Jordà

Is not required any level to be active student.

Both repertoire and continuo will be worked.

Free for Students who wish to participate as actives in Chamber Music and/or Baroque Orchestra.

Is required a minimum of 6 students to carry out this section. In any case, a maximum of 15 students will be admitted in order of registration, regardless of their level.

SINGING CHAMBER From July 28 to 30

teacher: Erika Escribá-Astaburuaga y Jorge E. García Ortega

To be admitted as active student it will be required some experience in singing chamber music.

Compositions will be worked on two, three and four voices (two by part). Compositions for chamber choir will also be worked on.

Technical, stylistic and expressive aspects of the interpretation will be addressed.

Is required a minimum of 10 students to carry out this section.

BAROQUE ORCHESTRA From July 28 to 30

teacher: Alba Roca

Are allowed to play in the orchestra every bowed and plucked-string instruments they wish to do it. Wind instruments, however, only will be required depending on the scores.

During part of the sessions the violins will be worked separately with Alba Roca and cellos with Leonardo Luckert.

Is required a minimum of 12 students to carry out this section.

CONCERT-COLLOQUIUM From July 31

La Dispersione

La Dispersione will present his next record project. Will interpret compositions by Monteverdi, Händel, Corselli, Comes, Pradas, Cabanilles... with Erika Escribá-Astaburuaga and Jorge E. García Ortega. In addition to the relevant explanations about the project, the music, the recording process, the public may consult or comment any matter that may be of interest to them.



GENERAL RULES OF THE COURSE

The Course focuses on workgroups, except of harpsichord. In no other case are individual classes.

Is essential to play historical instruments in all sections of the Course.

Harpsichord, positive organ and two sackbuts, a senior and a tenor (donation by Consolat de Mar Co.) Will be provided by the Course. Consort Flutes teacher will lend instruments if necessary.

The general schedule for every sessions in the Course is from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. That schedule may be modified at the discretion of the teacher.
